#### **Propane News**

As warm weather approaches, propane prices continue to drop. Pro-Flame Ridgewood's negotiated supplier continues to be the most competitive in the area. Today (4/15/15), the delivered price to Ridgewood residents that have joined our coop is \$1.13/gal. Pro-Flame has agreed to sell propane to Ridgewood residents at a price that is \$0.57 over the current San Francisco wholesale price. Obviously, the more Ridgewood residents who join our Pro-Flame propane plan the better the chance that we will keep, and possibly increase, our discount.
